



ETA REGISTRATION SHEET

An Electronic Travel Authority (ETA) is electronically recorded on Australian Government immigration systems. When you arrive at an airport for check-in on a flight to Australia, the check-in staff can electronically confirm that you have authority to board the flight to Australia. To be granted an ETA, you must be the holder of an ETA eligible passport. Some eligible passport holders, other than Taiwanese and UK-British National (overseas), can apply online at www.eta.immi.gov.au. ETA visitor and ETA short-validity business visas are free of charge. Visa applications that cannot be made online or through an ETA Travel agent can be lodged by mail to the address shown below:

- ✓ Completed ETA Registration Sheet
- ✓ Valid ETA eligible passport (<http://www.immi.gov.au/visitors/tourist/976/eligibility.htm>)
- ✓ Completed Express Post Authorization Form (http://www.australia.org.tw/tpei/AVS_Post_Authorisation.html)

All ETA applications will be posted back to the applicant's nominated address; please allow 5 days for postage.
